This tool is used during the installation of a new timing belt on models equipped with a manual tensioner.

Instructions for use:

1. Starting at the crankshaft sprocket fit the new timing belt ensuring that it is taut between sprockets on the non-tensioned side.
2. Fit the crankshaft pulley and tighten the bolts to 20nm
3. Mark the 8th tooth anti-clockwise from the TDC (Top Dead Centre) mark on the camshaft sprocket
4. Tension the belt using this tool
5. Rotate the crankshaft twice in clockwise direction until the mark on the 8th tooth aligns with the timing mark on the timing belt rear cover.
6. Tighten the tensioner bolt to 25Nm +450-600 using a torque wrench and angular torque gauge.
7. Remove the Timing Belt Tensioning Tool.
8. Reinstall all components in reverse order of removal
